Medical Clinic

Total patients were 7,979, of whom 3,040 were unable to pay because of limited financial resources to pay for their medicine.

-Pap smears- 486

-8 patients were detected with possible Cervical cancer, all of whom received treatment at the Cancer Center and are doing well.

- Financial assistance was given to 90 patients who had no money for the trip to Tegucigalpa.

There were 4 Mission Group Health Fairs that benefited 19 communities with educational activities and preventative health procedures. At these health Fairs more than 4,670 patients were attended to and 824 Pap smears were done. There were 36 new patients detected with hypertension and 40 with diabetes. More than 6,500 children and adult health kits were distributed.

There were 2,300 patients seen for dental hygiene.

There were 19 clean-up operations organized.

Dental Clinic

This year a total of 3,025 patients were taken care of whom 1,047 were unable to pay for their service due to limited financial resources. There were five fluoride campaigns in the elementary schools.

This year there were more fillings than extractions which is a significant change, primarily in the young people who are beginning to understand the importance of taking care of their teeth.

We gave 45 talks in the schools about oral hygiene.

This dental service is becoming very popular to the people of the communities. Little by little we are changing their health habits.
